- C. A copy of your bank statement or utility bill, which should not be older than three months.

RECOMMENDED METHOD OF PRONOUNCING ISLAMIC DIVORCE

Talaq in Shariah refers to the lawful process through which a marriage (Nikah) is dissolved. Within Islam, this procedure is intended to be utilized only in exceptional situations. It is reported that the Holy Prophet (Peace be upon Him) said:

**Of all things which have been permitted,
Divorce is the most hated by Allah. (Abu Daud)**

The approved method according to Shariah for divorce is as follows:

- A. The husband should initially pronounce only one Talaq.
- B. The Talaq should be pronounced when the wife is in a state of purity (Tuhur), meaning she is not menstruating.
- C. The Talaq should not be pronounced if the wife is pregnant.
- D. It is highly recommended that the husband consult a Muslim scholar before pronouncing Talaq.

By following this method, the husband retains the right of Raja' (return) to the divorced wife during the prescribed period of Iddah. However, this right is forfeited once the term expires, leading to a complete cessation of marital rights and duties. To reunite, the parties will need to enter into a new marriage.

If any part of the Mahr, the agreed upon dowry at the time of Nikah, remains outstanding, the husband should pay it at the time of divorce.

During the period of Iddah, the husband is expected to bear the expenses of his wife's maintenance, including food, clothing, accommodation, and medical expenses.
